(This Bible is now in the possession of Dr. Wayne McCulley DDS., Brown Building. (Bus. Addr.), or 1050 Ocoee Street NE, Cleveland, Tenn. 37311. (Residence) He is the grandson of Thomas J. and Martha Ann (Howell) McCulley, the great-grandson of Michael (Mikuel) and Mary (Polly Crowson) Howell, and the gr-gr-grandson of Aaron and Jane (Barnes) Crowson. He states that he found this old Bible, along with the McCulley Bible, in the attic of the old McCulley Mill, formerly known as the old Howell Mill. Dr. McCulley took both Bibles and had them rebound. With the exception of a few missing pages, this one is in very good condition, considering that it was printed in 1813. True, as he told me, it has a little mildew, and the pages are a little yellow from time, however, it looks very good for its age. It starts with page #58, and the last one #1028. The Crowson records are written in a beautiful old english script. After the Howell record started some parts were recorded in pencil and are no longer legible today. The handwriting indicates that various people have kept the Family Record Section, through the years. All of the children of the Howell's were not listed in it. It appears in later years that there were lon g periods of time when nothing was recorded in it. Dr. McCulley is very fortunate in having the old Bibles from both sides of kke his family.)
